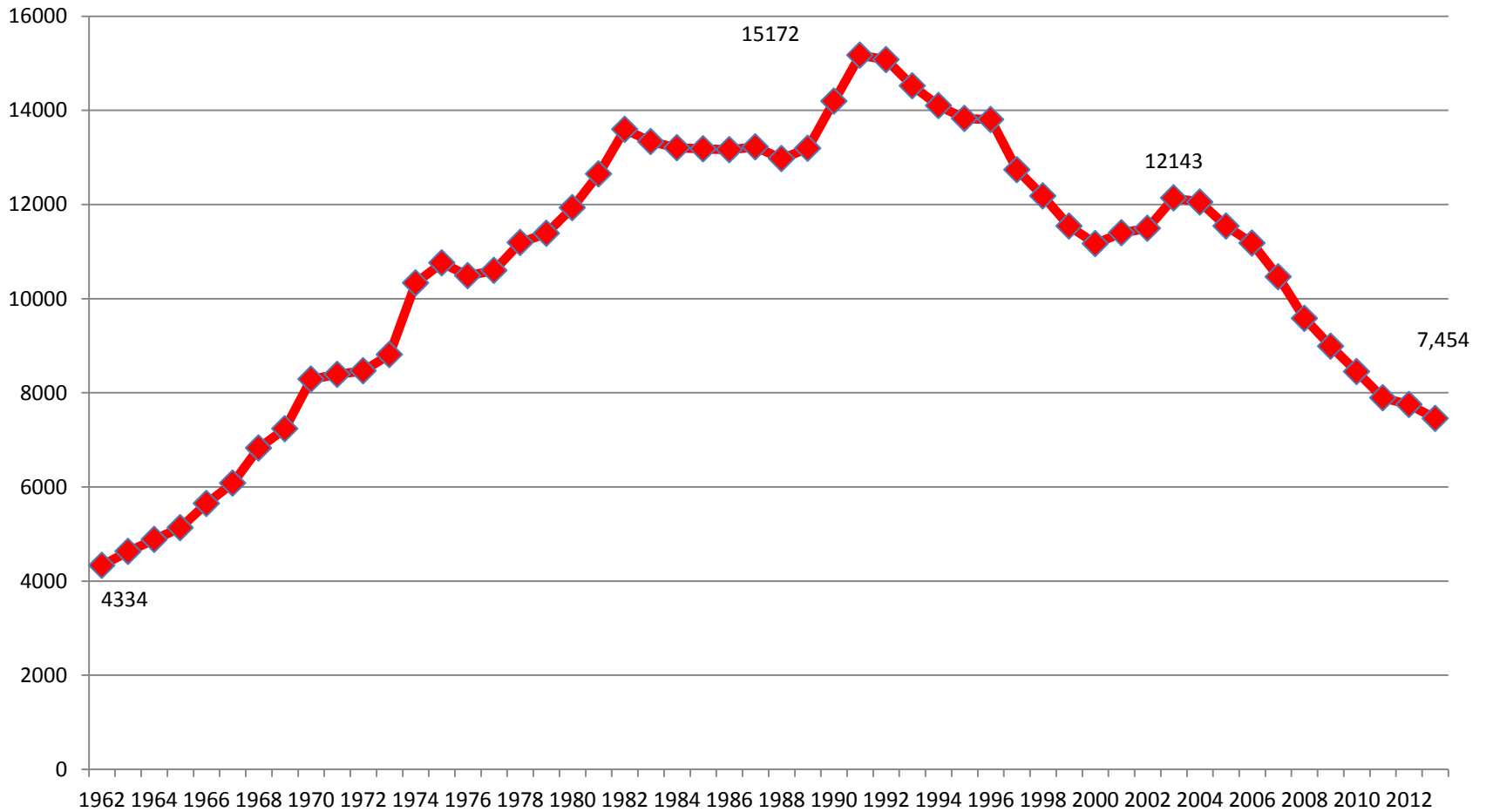

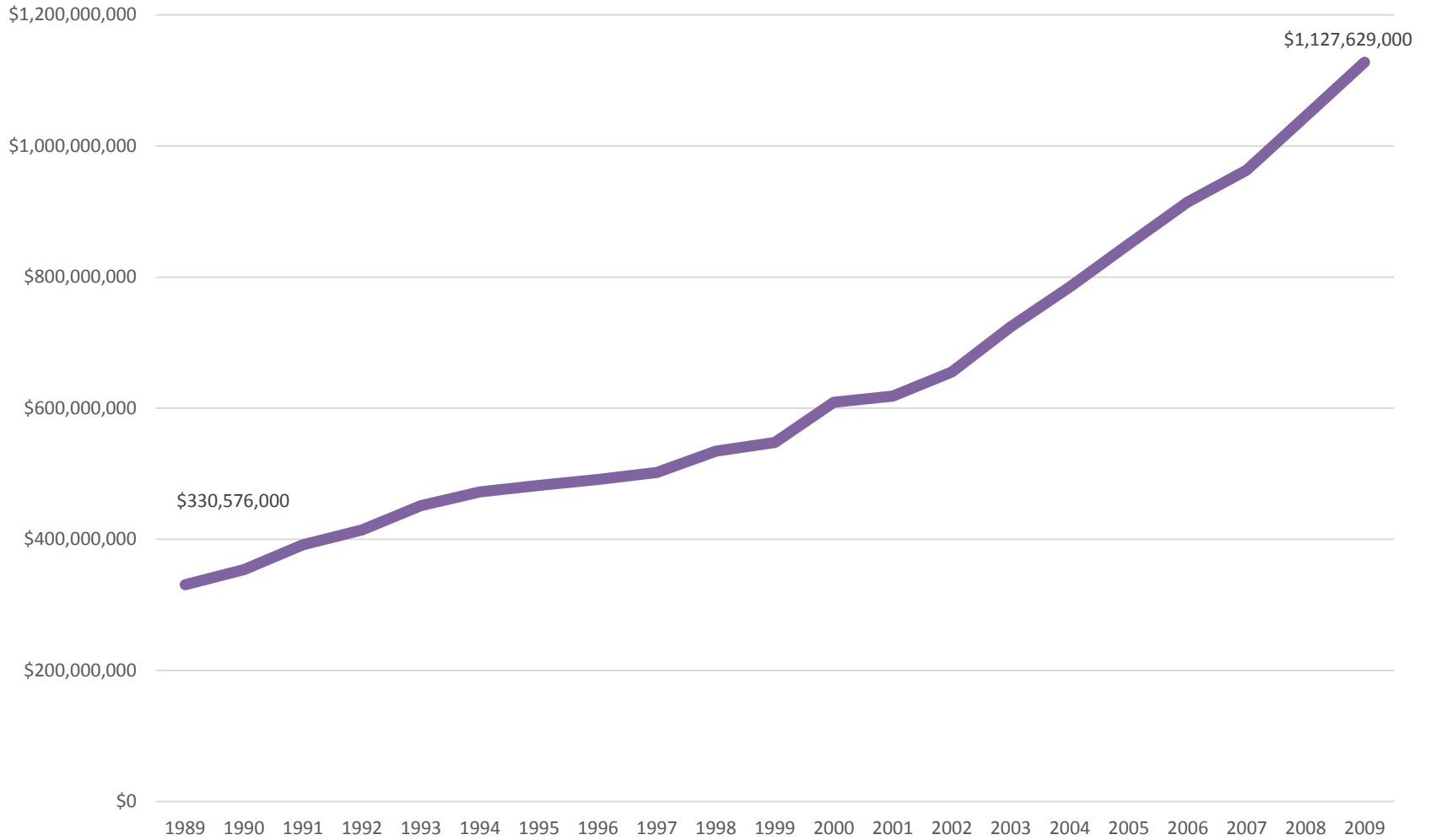

## Criminal Code Offence Rate (Excluding Traffic) British Columbia 1962-2013



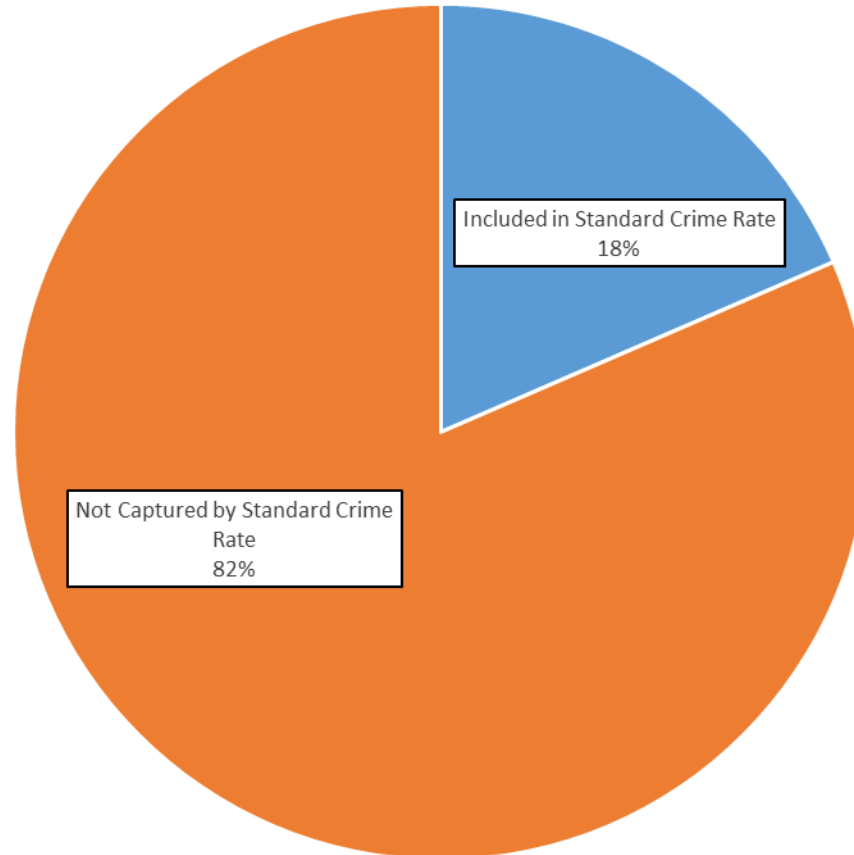
# Provincial Expenditures for Policing British Columbia 1989-2009



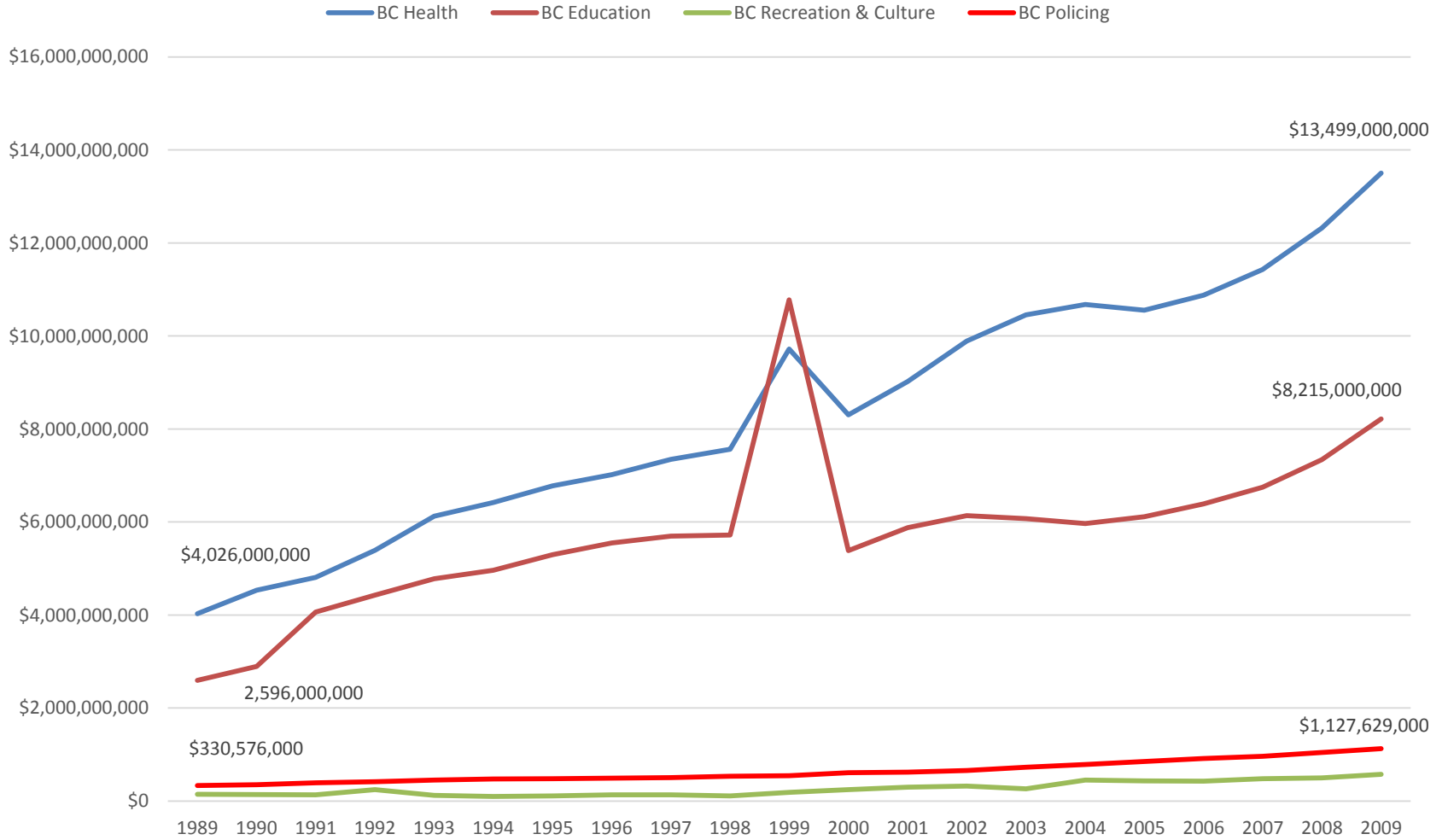
# Some Thoughts in Point

(n=4,558,023 Calls for Service)

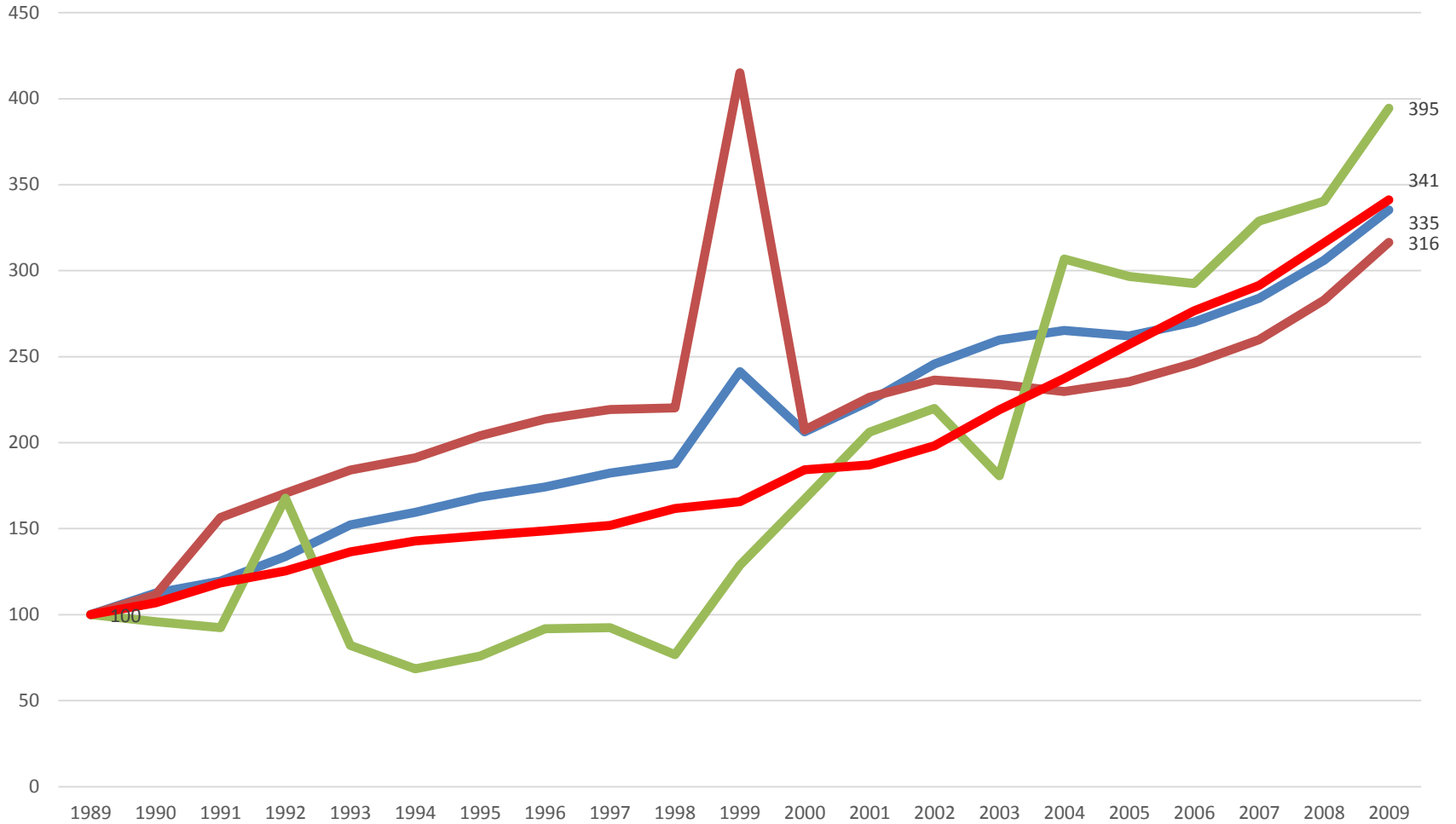

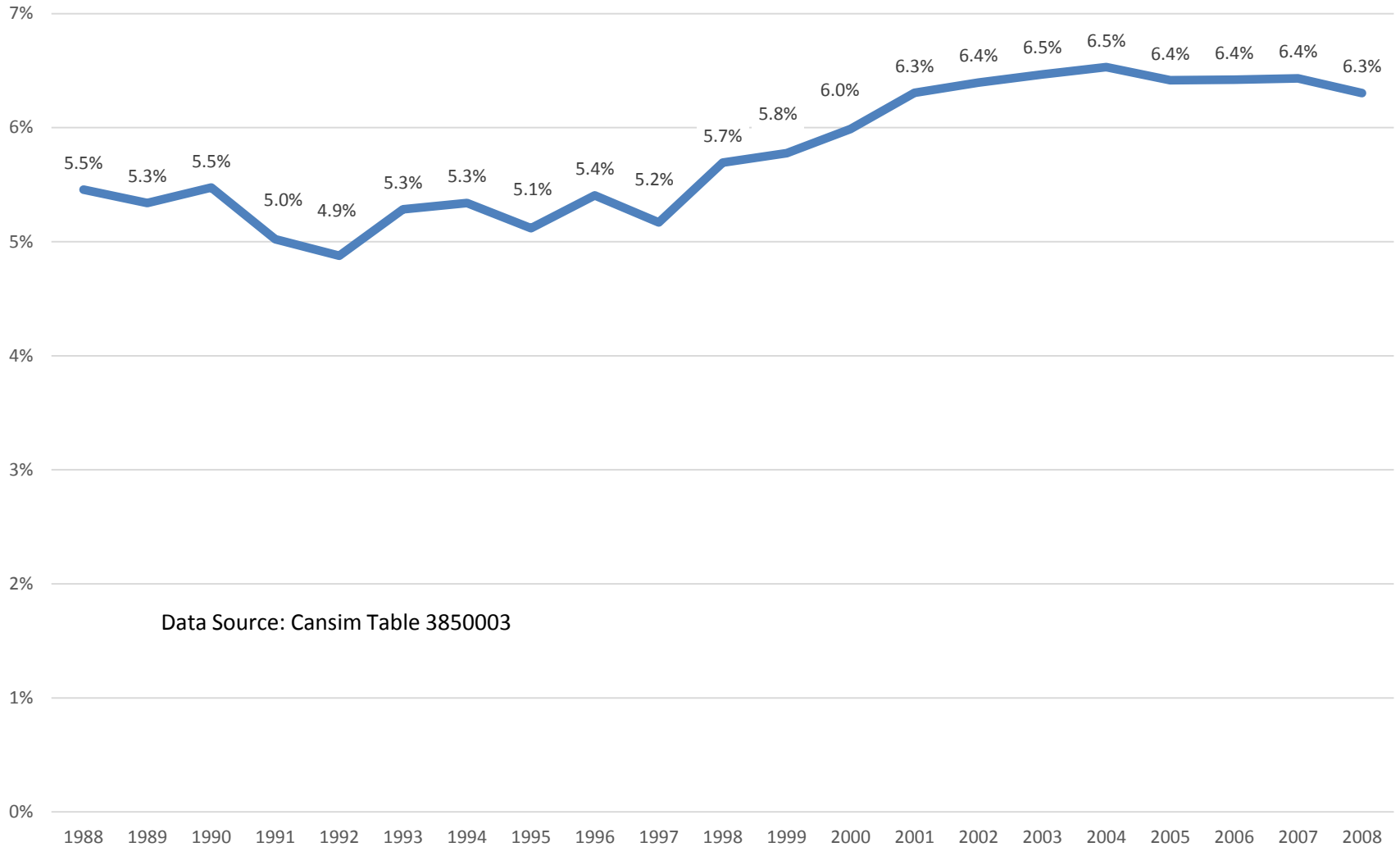
